

THE GLOBAL CLIMATE CRISIS: 2025 END-OF-YEAR UPDATE

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Update report.

Our last update, “*Update Report: mid-year 2025*,” was published in July 2025 and is available on our website. This report is different in that we are fully occupied with completing our next book on global warming, *Irreversible: What Can We Do?* It is in the final stage of production and should be released in early 2026. For that reason, this will not be a typical detailed year-end report.

New Book:

Irreversible emphasizes that we can cause the Earth to heat up, but not to cool down. Global warming is irreversible.

In this book, we have taken the time to summarize what we have learned over the past eight years in the process of writing *Reaching Net Zero* (2020) and *The Global Climate Crisis* (2024). It is an affordable paperback written for the interested, non-technical reader and will be accompanied by an ebook.

We have an extensive marketing plan to publicize the book and hopefully increase book sales. Any profits from the book will be used to distribute free books to libraries and schools.





Temperature update:

According to [Berkeley Earth](#) and other sources, the Earth’s average temperature is about 1.5°C (2.7°F) above the preindustrial 1850-1900 average. Following El Nino in 2024 that temporarily increased temperatures, the Earth’s temperature is returning to its long-term average, the red line in the figure below. To date, the land temperature increase averaged 2.24°C (4.0°F) and the ocean temperature increase averaged 0.95°C (1.7°F).



The International Panel on Climate Change's (IPCC) objective as stated in the 2015 Paris Agreement is to limit global temperature increases to well below 2°C (3.6°F) compared to pre-industrial levels, but with a target of 1.5°C (2.7°F) by 2050. It will take a few years of data to confirm if this lower limit has been permanently exceeded.



Temperature forecast:

According to [Climate Action Tracker](#), the Earth's average temperature increase by 2100, 75 years from now, is estimated to be between 2.5°C and 2.9°C (4.5°F and 5.2°F) depending upon the actions we take.
